

## The Confession

Deacon: We come to God as one from whom no secrets are hidden, to ask for his forgiveness and peace. Let us confess our sins.

**Lord our God, in our sin we have avoided your call.  
Our love for you is like a morning cloud, like the dew that goes away early.  
Have mercy on us; deliver us from judgement; bind up our wounds and revive us;  
in Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.**

Almighty God, who sent your Holy Spirit to be the life and light of your Church: open our hearts to the riches of your grace, that we may bring forth the fruit of the Spirit in love and joy and peace; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. **Amen.**



## The Gospel: Matthew 3.13-17

Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan, to be baptized by him. John would have prevented him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" But Jesus answered him, "Let it be so now; for it is proper for us in this way to fulfil all righteousness." Then he consented. And when Jesus had been baptized, just as he came up from the water, suddenly the heavens were opened to him and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased."
