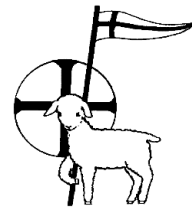

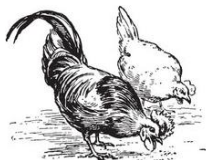
For your prayers
